A convenient space with a large hall (the Shibusawa Hall) and eight small and midsize conference rooms all on the same floor. It is in a great location directly linked to Nijubashi-mae Station and Hibiya Station on the Tokyo Metro, as well as to JR Tokyo Station via an underground passageway.

Meiji Yasuda Hall is a versatile venue that can be arranged either with retractable seating or as a flat hall.

Conference Square M+ is a versatile venue featuring seven small and midsize conference rooms. It is directly linked to Tokyo Station for unbeatable convenience.

JP TOWER Hall & Conference

Just a one-minute walk from Tokyo Station, JP Tower Hall & Conference is a versatile venue equipped to handle a variety of needs. From its 600-square-meter multipurpose hall to its many conference rooms, the space is perfect for anything from international conferences to seminars, exhibitions, and other events.

YOMIURI Otemachi Hall

Located inside the Tokyo headquarters for the Yomiuri Shimbun, the Yomiuri Otemachi Hall is a large, multipurpose space with seating for 501 guests, making it the perfect venue for symposiums, concerts, and more. There is also a small hall with a flat floor.

Tekko Executive Lounge & Conference Rooms

The fully-appointed facility offers web conferencing equipment, wired internet connections, WiFi, and more. It is also a carbon dioxide-free environment powered exclusively by renewable energy sources.

A traditional event facility with a banquet hall large enough to hold two thousand guests. It has recently undergone its third renovation, with the theme "New Classics". The windows of its banquet halls delight guests with expansive views of the Imperial Palace.

Otemachi-Nakadori Street

This tree-lined street passes through the skyscrapers of Otemachi in the heart of the Tokyo business district. It is available as a unique venue for private events.

3x3 Lab Future

3x3 Lab Future provides "third place" in the community for engaging with a variety of economic, environmental, and social issues in a solution-oriented way. In addition to an event space available, visitors can arrange to take tours of the water purification plant for the moat surrounding the Imperial Palace, which is located in the basement of the building.

Sky Lab

Surrounded by skyscrapers, the space of approx. 4,000 square meters is like a floating garden.you can enjoy the view of the greenery Marunouchi-Nakadori Street and the Imperial Palace during daytime, and impressive metropolis view at night. The space can be used for business events or party up to the number of people and purpose.

Kanda Myoujin Shrine

Kanda Myoujin, originally constructed 1,300 years ago, is one of the few shrines in Tokyo that serves as both a traditional place of worship and a unique event space. In addition to the Myoujin Kaikan shrine complex, the site is home to the EDOCCO Edo Culture Complex, dedicated to preserving the traditions of Japan while offering opportunities for fresh cultural discovery.

Idemitsu Museum of Arts

Exhibits showcase the museum's outstanding collection of traditional Japanese art. The lobby also offers lovely views of the Imperial Palace gardens. The museum's collection of nearly 10,000 pieces features two national treasures and 57 Important Cultural Properties.

Mitsubishi Ichigokan Museum, Tokyo

Mitsubishi Ichigokan as a red brick building was originally constructed in 1894 as an office building. It was reconstructed to the museum and opened its doors in 2010. It hosts three special exhibitions a year, most of them showcasing modern art. Another draw is its art collections, which features mainly Western art from the late 19th century. The museum café and shop are also worth visiting.

The National Museum of Modern Art, Tokyo (MOMAT)

Constructed alongside the Imperial Palace, the National Museum of Modern Art, Tokyo is Japan's first national art museum. It houses numerous masterpieces of Japanese art, spanning from the Meiji era to modern times. The museum also offers teambuilding workshops for MICE event participants.

Slit Park YURAKUCHO

Located between two office buildings, this L-shaped alley space is like a "forest of encounter" where people can relax, chat, eat and drink. Wi-Fi and power supply is equipped and suitable venue for open-air galleries and events.

35

Marunouchi-Nakadori Street

One of the hallmark streets of Chiyoda City. It is a space filled with lush greenery that runs for 1.2 kilometers north-south, functioning as an urban terrace of relaxation during the daytime. It was awarded the TripAdvisor Certificate of Excellence in 2019.

36

TOKIA Galleria

"Galleria" is a spacious open space on the 1st floor of Tokyo Building TOKIA. Having 10m wide, 70m depth, and 18m high, it is an ideal venue for open events such as concerts, art exhibitions, etc.

37

MARUCUBE

An entrance space of Marunouchi Building. The vaulted ceiling and glass exterior wall integrated with Marunouchi Nakadori Street, creating a large plaza, which can be used for a variety of purposes, from small-scale closed exhibitions to dynamic events taking advantage of the large space.

Gyoko-dori Underground Gallery

220-m long glass showcases gallery in the underground passage linking the Marunouchi Bldg. and Shin-Marunouchi Bldg. in front of Tokyo Station. It can be used for various exhibits that make the most of its scale without being impacted by the weather.

(marunouchi) HOUSE

A distinctive collection of restaurants located on the seventh floor of the Shin-marunouchi Building across from Tokyo Station. It hosts live DJ performances each week, an exciting nightlife, and gorgeous views of the Tokyo Marunouchi Station building and the surrounding district from its outdoor terrace seating. Some of the restaurants and spaces are available for private events.

40

OOplaza

Located next to Tokyo station, this 100 square meter space on the 1st floor of Marunouchi Oazo is an open space for various events.

TOKYO TORCH Park

The stage in the center of the park faces the facade of the lively restaurant. A wide variety of events can be held in this spacious park.

Size of largest space : 350㎡
